- Students must complete AP/EN 1001 3.0 with a grade of C or better to be eligible to take AP/EN 1002 3.0. Additionally, they must complete EN AP/EN1002 3.0 with a grade of C or better to be eligible to continue in the major.
- Students may not use courses offered in the Pop Genres (3170 3.0-3179 3.0) series for the CRWR major, except by permission of the Program Coordinator.
- Students may count only 6 credits from the Pop Genres (3170 3.0-3179 3.0) series toward their English major.
- Residency requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50%) of the course credits required in the major or minor must be taken at York University.
- Upper-level credits: at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level, with at least 18 of those credits at the 4000 level according to the Faculty of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies legislation; however, EN/CRWR double majors will more than exceed this requirement because at least 12 credits must be at the 3000 level in CRWR, 12 at the 3000 in EN, and 12 credits at the 4000 level in CRWR, and 12 credits in EN at the 4000 level.
