- Students may not use courses offered in the Pop Genres (3170. 3.0-3179 3.0) series for the CRWR Minor, except by permission of the Program Coordinator.
- Students may count only 6 credits from the Pop Genres (3170. 3.0-3179 3.0) series toward their English major.
- Residency requirement: a minimum of 30 course credits and at least half (50%) of the course credits in the major or minor must be taken at York University.
- Upper-level credits: at least 36 credits at the 3000-4000 level. 18 credits must be at the 3000 level, including 6 credits in Creative Writing and 12 credits in English and 18 credits must be at the 4000 level, including 6 credits in Creative Writing and 12 credits in English.
